COVID-19 vaccine now available to 12- to 15-year-olds

It is requested that a valid government issued ID or birth certificate be presented at the time of registration.

Transportation to and from MCATS is free and available for minors with signed parent consent forms. To avail of the free transportation, register online at www.vaccinatecnmi.com, or call 682-SHOT (7468).

12- to 17-year-olds who complete their 2-dose series will receive gift bags.

The operation at MCATS will run Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.; and Saturdays, 8 a.m. to noon.

School-based vaccination is being planned at selected schools, to be announced at a later date.

Additionally, a comprehensive vaccination service is available for 12- to 17-year-olds. All individuals who avail of this service will receive the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccination, plus all pending routine vaccination shots.
